Dutch Life Sciences popular with foreign talent

The "International Talent meets Dutch Life Sciences" project held in May this year was carried out in collaboration with the organiser of the BCF event, Hyphen Projects. Fifty talented scientists from 18 countries were selected and invited to the Netherlands to get to know the Dutch Life Sciences sector. A four-day programme introduced them to research institutes, medical centres, science parks and companies in the bio-regions Wageningen, Nijmegen and Amsterdam. During the BCF event speed dates were arranged with interested employers. Two weeks after the event already five participants had accepted a job with a Dutch employer, and 93% indicated

an interest in applying for a position in the Netherlands.
